CARNIVAL REPORT WESTS AUBURN: 10 December 2016 at the Birrong Leisure Centre.

With our home pool (Ruth Everuss Aquatic Centre) closed for reconstruction, we moved our carnival down the road to Birrong Leisure Centre.

Due to the expense of booking the pool in daylight hours, we decided on a twilight sprint (50m) carnival.

We had 92 entries registered from 17 clubs this year and the weather was fine and warm.

No records were broken, but swimming was keen, in the usual friendly Auburn atmosphere.

Overall pointscore winners on the day were Ryde (795 points), with Wests coming second (242) and Warringah third (221). Ryde were honoured with the virtual trophy for the winning visiting club.

Average pointscore winners were Ryde and Merrylands (26.5 points) with third to Warringah (24.5).

Timekeeping was difficult at times, with such a fast paced list of events, but we still got through in good time.

Thank you to all our officials (referees, judges, starters, marshals, check starters, and timekeepers), who continue to give their time so freely to allow carnivals to run.

We look forward to our long distance carnival in December 2017, and hope to be in our brand new pool!
