Individual Entries

- SWIMMERS MUST LODGE THEIR ENTRIES ONLINE through [Swim Central](#).

Relay Entries

1. Clubs nominate the total number of relay teams & pay through the [online form](#) on the website.
2. Nominated club officials subsequently submit full team details for each relay team through the [MSNSW Relay App](#):



Entry and editing of team details will be available for nominated Relay Captains up to 2hrs before the scheduled start time of the first relay event each day.

- To be eligible to swim in a relay, a swimmer must have entered at least one individual event.
- There is no limit on the number of teams that a club may enter in any age group. All teams may score points.

Warm-up facilities

- Warm-up and swim-down facilities will be available in the diving pool during the meet.

Timekeeping

- Clubs are expected to assist with timekeeping.

Rules

- This competition will be governed by the rules of Masters Swimming Australia and Masters Swimming NSW in force at the closing date for entries.
- Pool is surveyed, and Automatic Officiating Equipment will be utilised to validate State, National and World records.
- No watches to be worn in warm up or competition.
- All 50m events will be seeded as separate male and female heats

Awards

CLUB

- **State Cup Championship Trophy** to the club with the highest point score in each division.
- **Executive Trophy** to the club with the highest percentage of members competing (minimum of 10 swimmers competing).
- **Biddy Hall Memorial Trophy** to the club with the highest average point score per swimmer (minimum of 10 swimmers competing).

INDIVIDUAL

-  **Male & Female Swimmer of the Meet.**
- **Peter Gilmour Memorial Trophy** to the best butterfly swim relative to current records.
- **Medals** to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placegetters in each individual event in each age group for MSNSW members. Visitors are also eligible for medals.
- Medals to each member of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd relay team in each age group of each event.

PRESENTATIONS

- The trophies for these Long Course Championships will be presented at the end of the meet.
