	MEDLEY SHOOTOUT
1. 100m Individual Medley	The 8 fastest men and 8 fastest women in the 100m Individual Medley (Event 1) will be invited to participate in separate shootouts. The shootouts will be swum as 4x25m races, one for each stroke with the two slowest swimmers being eliminated until there are only two left in the final. The stroke sequence will be drawn randomly.
2. 50m Backstroke	
3. 100m Breaststroke	
4. 50m Butterfly	
5. 100m Backstroke	
6. 100m Freestyle	
7. 25m Freestyle (not before 12:00)	11. 50m Breaststroke
8. 25m Breaststroke	12. 100m Butterfly
9. 25m Butterfly	13. 50m Freestyle
10. 25m Backstroke	14. 4x25m Medley Relay Women's/Men's/Mixed

COST: \$27.00 (incl. transaction fees)
plus pool entry payable to the WAC on entry - \$3.60, spectators \$4.50

CLOSING DATE: Midday Friday 19 June 2026

- For Masters Swimming members only
- Swimmers are permitted **four individual events plus one relay.**
- No late entries, no non-point scoring entries
- The terms of our pool booking do not allow entry to meet attendees prior to 9.30am. Entry prior to 9.30am will require payment of normal entry fee. Organised warm up swimming will not be allowed before 10.00am.
