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Individual Entries

- Swimmers must lodge their entries online through [Swim Central](#).

Relay Entries

- Clubs nominate the total number of relay teams & pay by midday October 7, by following the link on the Events page of the website to the online form.

Nominated club officials subsequently submit full team details for each relay team through the [MSNSW Relay App](#):



- Entry and editing of team details will be available for nominated Relay Captains up to 2hrs before the scheduled start time of the first relay event each day.
- To be eligible to swim in a relay, a swimmer must have entered at least one individual event.
- There is no limit on the number of teams that a club may enter in any age group. All teams may score points.

Warm-up facilities

- The part of the pool not used for competition will be available for warm-up and swim-down during the meet.

Lunch

- A lunch break will be held each day, where time allows.

Timekeeping


- ALL swimmers are expected to assist with timekeeping.

Awards

Club

- Trophies to the club with the highest point score in each division.
- Harry Fowler Memorial Trophy** for the outstanding performance by a relay team with a combined age of 200 years or over.
- Gordon Cozins Memorial Trophy** for the club scoring the highest total points in relays.
- Des McCormick Memorial Trophy** for the club with the highest average point score per swimmer (minimum of 10 competitors).

Individual

-  Male & Female Swimmer of the Meet.
- Medals to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placegetters in each individual event in each age group for NSW members. Visitors are also eligible for medals.

Relay

- Medals to each member of the 1st, 2nd & 3rd relay team in each age group of each event.

Rules

- This competition will be governed by the rules of Masters Swimming Australia and Masters Swimming NSW in force at the closing date for entries.
- MSNSW **SunSmart Sport & No Smoking** policies, and MSA **Warm-Up Safety** policy will apply at this meet— please obey all signs & official instructions.
- No watches are to be worn during warm up, or during competition.
