Medical Disability form for swimsuits It has been brought to the Boards attention that the rules of masters swimming do not make allowances for those who may for medical reasons, have specific swimwear requirements. Eg non-compliant fabric, extra strapping or padding. For this reason the <u>NSW</u> Board has created an exemption form to be signed by a medical practitioner advising referees about the individuals' needs. Form attached. <u>Please note:</u> This is NOT a Masters Swimming Australia exemption and would not be accepted at interstate or National competition.

Endurance 1000 swims to be finalised NOW Has your club recorder entered all your swims in the End1000 program? You need to check your own results by going to <a href="http://e1000.mastersswimming.org.au/">http://e1000.mastersswimming.org.au/</a> /History and enter your name.

Club affiliation (early bird) fee now due Only \$40 if received at the branch office by 31st December, \$50 from 1st January. Both the Affiliation form and Club Committee form have been sent direct to the listed club contact. Can clubs please assist by returning these as soon as possible. Nearly half of our clubs have not paid the affiliation fee as of 20 December! This means that YOU may not be eligible to swim at Campbelltown or have times recognised for postal swims, endurance swims etc. So support your club executive and ask if they need a hand right now to get on top of the end of year paperwork.

<u>Coach of the Year Nominations</u> are due by 24 January. Please consider honouring your tireless coach by putting their name forward. Recognition is all that many of our time-giving coaches get. Also, clubs can consider paying \$10 for a 'non-swimming Coach membership'.

Official of the Year To be eligible for consideration, nominees must be an accredited Masters Swimming Technical Official, be a current member from 1 January and must have made an outstanding contribution in officiating and/or towards the development of officiating at Club, Branch and/or National level. For example: attended courses to enhance knowledge and interpretation of rules; delivered courses to prospective officials; or taken the position of mentor to trainee officials. Nominations are due by 24 January.
