Small print- Be aware that the information may be used for publicity purposes. Take a moment to look around your club... do you have non-swimming volunteers or a non-member coach? From 1st December your club can purchase them a \$10 annual membership and they then become eligible for VoM or Coach of the Year awards. Appreciate them by honouring them with this small token of your respect.

Treasurers and Race Secretaries You must coordinate payment with entries for ALL meets!

This note has been in the last few Monthly Newsletters as it has been a concern and frustration for many of those involved on all sides. The solution may now be at hand—for the Hornsby meet on 16 January we are trialling an **individual online entry system** within the IMGSTG console. Race Secretaries can relax! Members need to know their username & password (that they use when renewing their membership every year) then follow the easy steps. ANY problems? A youtube video has been created to give you step by step assistance.

This may be the most exciting and refreshing change we have experienced in quite some time and commonplace in other branches. Now NSW has stepped into the future and allowing each member to put their own swims and times into the system and paying as they go. No more transferring of funds to their club then treasurers sending on to host clubs. Cutting out the middle men should prove a more efficient and streamlined

system. Race Secretaries will still need to send on flyers and regularly remind their members of closing dates.

Medical Disability form for swimsuits For those among us that, for medical reasons, have specific swimwear requirements eg non-compliant fabric, extra strapping or padding, the MSNSW Board has created an exemption form to be signed by a medical practitioner advising referees about the individuals' needs.

Please note: This is NOT a Masters Swimming Australia exemption and would not be accepted at interstate or National competition.

2016 MSNSW swim meet calendar is at the printers and it is hoped that many will be distributed before Christmas. Those that are swimming at Wests Auburn may be the first to receive them.

<u>Coach of the Year</u> Nominations are open. http://www.mastersswimmingnsw.org.au/Downloads/Forms. Please consider honouring your tireless coach by putting their name forward. Recognition is all that many of our volunteer coaches get so put your thinking caps on. Clubs can consider paying \$10 for a 'non-swimming Coach membership'.

Official of the Year Nominations are open. To be eligible for consideration, nominees must be an accredited Masters Swimming Technical Official, be a current member from 1 January and have made an outstanding contribution in officiating and/or towards the development of officiating at Club, Branch and/or National level. For example: They attended courses to enhance knowledge and interpretation of rules; or delivered courses to prospective officials; or taken the position of mentor to trainee officials. Coaches, Technical Officials and Volunteers can join Masters Swimming Australia for \$10 per year. In the Membership portal on the home page choose Non Swimmer in the State drop down box then NSW in the Club drop down box and follow the prompts. Congratulations to our clubs that pay this on behalf of their workers, all clubs are encouraged to reward their non-swimming Coaches, Officials and Volunteers with their own membership.

All 12 month memberships expire on 31st December 2015

On 31st December 2015 <u>all 12 month memberships expire</u> so Club Registrars need to spread the word that once they open their 2016 membership on 1 December <u>all members will want to re-join before December ends.</u>

Note: If swimming while unfinancial there is NO insurance cover.

<u>Updating your emergency contacts information</u> When you re-join online in December you will be prompted to review your emergency contacts information. Most members do not update any details in the data base and some leave it to their clubs to organise so please take a moment to check your important contact details. Now included is "medical conditions your coach needs to know", this is a voluntary field to be filled in if you wish to do so. <u>Registrars take note</u>: every Masters Swimming Australia member agrees to a Safety in Activity statement when they re-join each year, providing they <u>ACTUALLY</u> register themselves! Please don't take on this responsibility yourself but rather encourage and assist members to re-join themselves.
