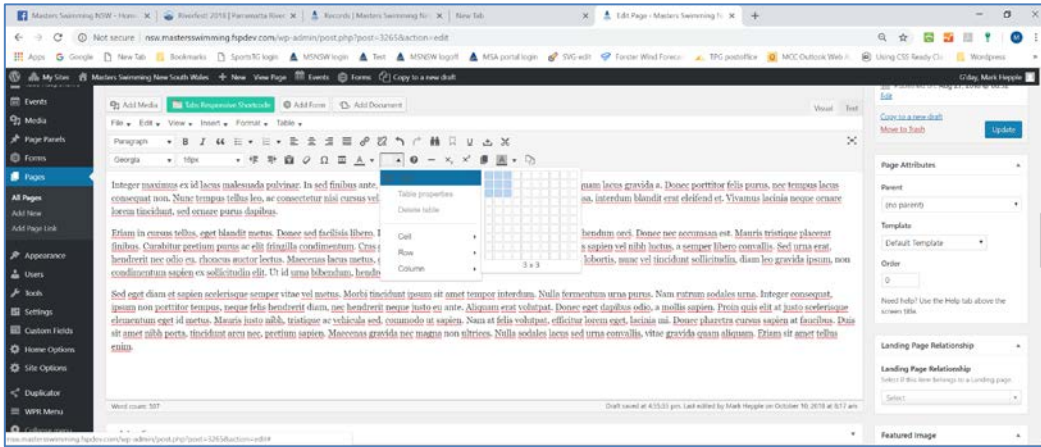
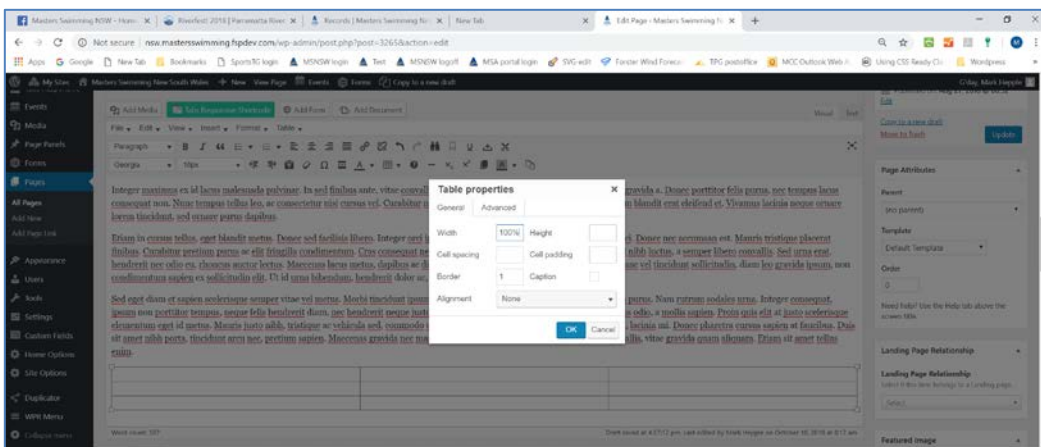
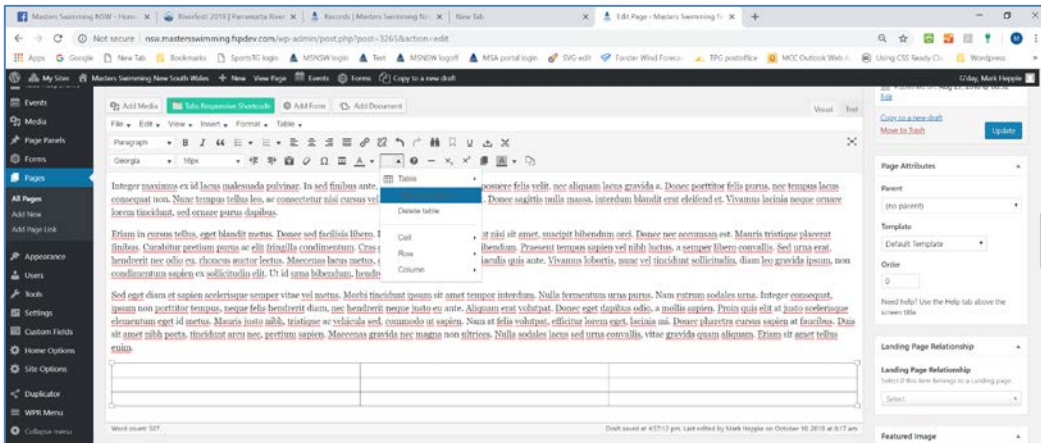


Wordpress Tables

To create a table, put the cursor where you want it to go, and click the Table icon in the editor menu. Highlight the number of rows and columns that you want.

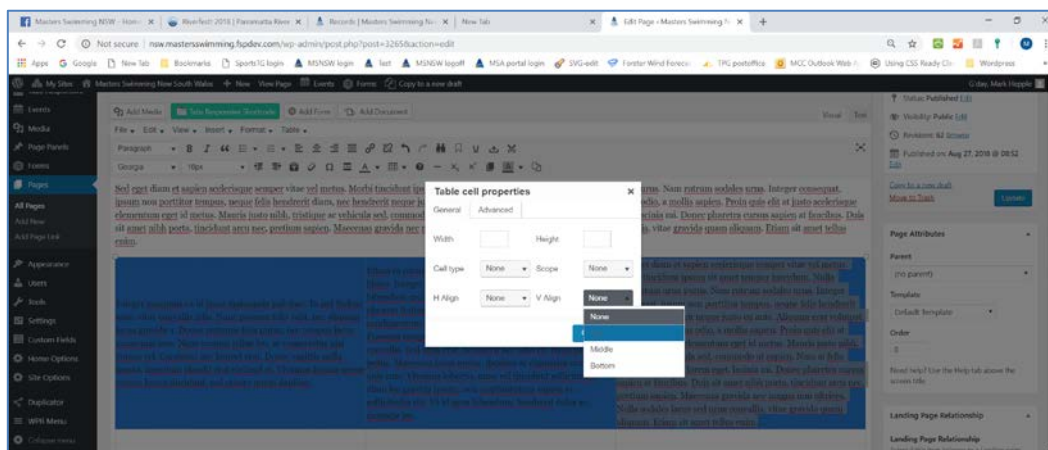


If you want the contents to appear as text in columns, rather than a table, click the Table icon in the editor menu again, select 'Table Properties', and set 'Border' to zero (0).

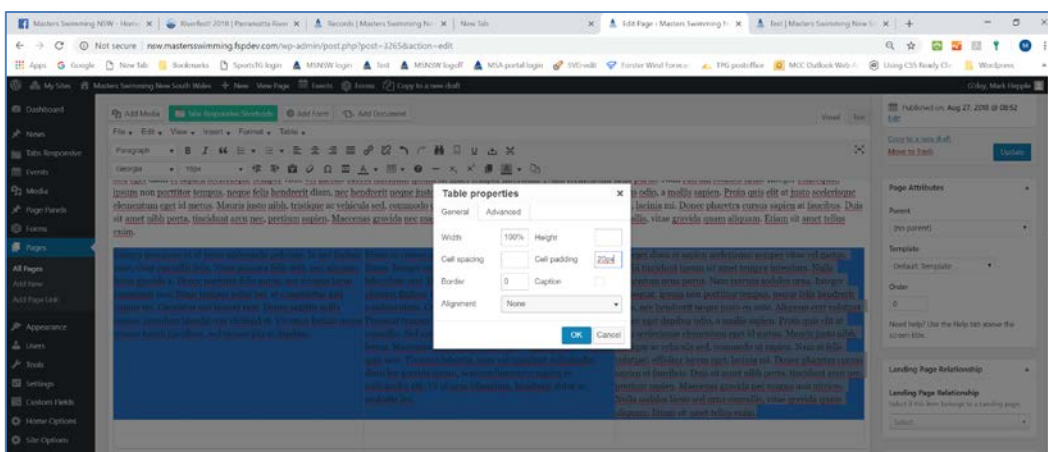


After adding text to table cells, you will probably find text block centred vertically within the table

cell. You may wish to re-align the text to the top, or bottom.
 Select the cells that you want to affect, click the Table icon in the editor menu and select 'Cell Properties, then 'V Align' to 'Top'.



If you have a lot of text and it extends right across the columns, you may want to create some space between the columns. Click the Table icon in the editor menu, select 'Table Properties' and set 'Cell Padding' to say 20px.



The results of the above will then look something like this:
