A maximum of 100 participants will be admitted to the pool, including volunteers.  Due to limited numbers, and to ensure that all those attending get an opportunity to swim, it is requested that members do not bring family and friends.  ALL participants must keep at least 1½m apart at all times.  No grouping inside or outside of the venue pre/post event  Take time to read the conditions of entry to the venue.  Please adhere strictly to any instructions provided by the staff of Cabarita Swimming Centre.  Come prepared to have FUN

Warm up will be conducted in accordance with safety procedures, please observe all safety signs.

Maximum of three (3) individual events per swimmer plus a relay

Cost: \$15 per swimmer

Pool entry not included, please pay at gate

Closing date: midday Friday 19 February 2021

#### **Entries**

- Swimmers may individually lodge their entries electronically through the SportsTG system, and pay by credit card or PayPal. A link to step-by-step instructions on this entry process may be found on the "Events" page for this meet on the MSNSW website.
- Swimmers' ages will be calculated as at 31 December 2021.

## The Relay

To be eligible to swim in the relay, a swimmer must have <u>entered</u> at least one individual event.

## **Timekeeping**

Swimmers are requested to bring stopwatches as all swimmers are expected to assist with timekeeping.

#### Rules

- This competition will be governed by the rules of Masters Swimming Australia and Masters Swimming NSW in force at the closing date for entries.
- There will be no marshalling, swimmers are expected to be behind their block prior to their swim

### Warm-up facilities

- Warm-up and swim-down facilities will be available throughout the meet.
- Number of swimmers in warm up lanes may be limited due to COVID guidelines.

Cabarita Swimming Centre must follow the COVID-19 Public Health orders current at the time, and also manage risks to staff and patrons in accordance to Work Health and Safety laws. They have a strict COVID-19 Safety Plan in place to look after us. It is up to swimmers to comply with any instructions.
