The MSA Non-swimming membership is a great option for our Volunteers, Coaches, Officials and Social members who wish to be connected to the Masters Swimming community and now to their clubs. A Non-swimming membership does not entitle members to swim at training or to compete in any meets, postal swims, E1000, Million Metres program.

With Swim Central we can now offer the Non-swimming memberships a little differently. The Non-swimming memberships are 'Dry' memberships from as little as \$10 (this is the MSA National component – Clubs may add a fee to this)

In 2023 we can offer Non-swimming memberships by:

- Joining the MSA Non-swimming Club
 - When logged into Swim Central go to Store
 - Click on Memberships
 - o Type in MSA Non-swimmer Club in the Find a Club search field
- Joining the NSW Non-Swimmer Club
 - When logged into Swim Central go to Store
 - o Click on Memberships
 - o Type in NSW non-swimmer club in the Find a Club search field
- OR your club may offer the Non-swimming membership product
 - MSA \$10 + Club component if applicable
 - It pays to check with the <u>MSNSW office</u> or your club to see if they will be offering this for the year

To purchase a Non-swimming membership:

If you do not have a profile already in Swim Central you need to create one

- Login to Swim Central
- Click on Don't have a login? Register for an account
- Follow the steps to create a profile and verify your email address
- Return to the login page and log into Swim Central

If you have a profile in Swim Central

- Login to <u>Swim Central</u> using the email address associated with your existing profile
- If you have forgotten your password do s forgot password request
- Once you have logged in search for the MSA Non-swimming Branch or search for your club and select the Non-swimming product

If you have been a swimming member but no longer wish to swim then you can purchase this membership – please note **DO NOT** purchase this Non-swimming membership if you intend to pick up swimming again in the same calendar year.

Please check the club name when purchasing a membership product; that it is the correct Club you are wanting to join and is a Masters Club as some Swimming Australia clubs have similar names. Most Masters Swimming Australia clubs will have the word 'masters' in their name but some do not.
