Call for nominations - MSA Governance sub-committee

Overview:

Masters Swimming Australia (MSA) is the peak national body for the sport of amateur adult swimming in Australia. It is a federated, incorporated association governed by a Constitution and requisite by-laws. Owing to the dynamic and evolving nature of the administration of sport in Australia, the need to constantly review the organisational and governance structures of MSA is considered necessary.

Purpose:

To provide guidance and advice to the National Board of Management (NBM) of MSA to inform the governance and administrative structures of the organisation, with a view to any changes being recommended to Branches for consideration by the Autumn 2024 Annual General Meeting.

Membership:

Up to six members are sought to participate on the committee. Unless otherwise elected as a member in their own right, a member of the NBM will be an additional and non-voting observer of the sub-committee.

Eligibility:

Current MSA Club or Associate Members & nominee of a MSA Branch, or employee of MSA

Desirable:

The sub-committee would benefit from members with experience in administration and/or governance policy, associations and/or corporations law, corporate strategy, and organisational design. Roles and responsibilities:

- Review the Constitution and Bylaws of Masters Swimming Australia and determine their efficacy and fitness for purpose
 - Consider comparable organisations' structure and governance arrangements.
- Recommend any changes that may be required to MSA's structure, administrative or organisational arrangements.

Timeframe:

Any governance-related changes are to be implemented not later than 30 June 2024.

Chairperson:

Following the sub-committee's establishment, the members shall elect a Chairperson. Chair's role and responsibilities:

- Co-ordinate and chair meetings of the Committee Instigate and co-ordinate committee discussion / feedback on programs and documents.
- Provide minutes of meetings for the National Board of Management and written reports for General Meetings and for the Annual Report.
- Provide recommendations to the National Board of Management for their consideration Please communicate to all members the call for nominations.

All nominations can be sent to the General Manager by COB Monday 13 February 2023
