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## Team Challenge

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### **1. What is the team challenge?**

The team challenge is where Masters Swimming members have the opportunity to swim with people from different clubs and swim “novel” events that are not usually part of the regular program.

#### **2. Why do I need to enter a 50m freestyle time on Swim Central?**

Each swimmer is required to provide this time when registering as it will be used to assess individual abilities and evenly allocate swimmers to teams.

#### **3. How many teams will there be?**

There will be up to 10 teams created following the close of registration but may be less depending on the total number of entrants.

#### **4. How do I find out what team I am in?**

There will be team captain allocated to each team and the team captain will be in contact with each member of the team. The team captain will determine which individual from the team swims in which event. The captain will consider preferences of swimmers and not put swimmers into an event they are not capable of.

#### **4. How much will it cost?**

The cost to member is \$10 and can be paid via Swim Central

#### **5. What is the start time and approximate end time?**

We have warm up scheduled for 10am with a 10:30am start and approximately finished by 1pm.

#### **6. How does it work?**

Each swimmer will compete in a minimum of 3 individual and maximum of 4 individual events. Each team will have 1 swimmer per heat. Each heat will be swum as a final with 10 points awarded to 1st, 9 for 2nd, 8 for 3rd and so on. Relays are awarded double points.
