## **Individual Entries**

- SWIMMERS MUST LODGE THEIR ENTRIES ONLINE through Swim Central.
- Step-by-step instructions on this entry process may be found on the "Events" page for this meet on the MSNSW website.

## **Relay Entries**

- Club Officials must nominate and pay for the total number of relay teams, through Swim Central at this link.
  - Entries open Friday October 6 and close on Friday October 13.
  - Select "Relay Teams" under the "Products" tab, nominate the total number of teams using the +/-buttons, and submit online payment.
- Club officials must subsequently submit swimmer details for each relay team through the MSNSW Live Results app on phone, tablet or computer:
  - Shortly after closing time of individual entries, a nominated Relay Captain will be activated to enable them to submit full relay team details (swimmer names & nominated times)
  - Adding, or editing, of teams will be available for nominated Relay Captains under the "Relay Entries" tab within the Live Results app up to 2hrs before the scheduled start time of the first relay event each day

- To be eligible to swim in a relay, a swimmer must have <u>entered</u> at least one individual event.
- There is no limit on the number of teams that a club may enter in any age group. All teams may score points.

## Warm-up facilities

 The part of the pool not used for competition will be available for warm-up and swim-down during the meet.

## **Timekeeping**

Clubs are expected to assist with timekeeping.

#### **Awards**

#### Club

- Trophies to the club with the highest point score in each division.
- Harry Fowler Memorial Trophy for the outstanding performance by a relay team with a combined age of 200 years or over.
- o Gordon Cozins Memorial Trophy for the club scoring the highest total points in relays.
- Des McCormick Memorial Trophy for the club with the highest average point score per swimmer (minimum of 10 competitors).

#### Individual

- o **evorgee** Male & Female Swimmer of the Meet.
- Medals to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placegetters in each individual event in each age group for NSW members. Visitors are also eligible for medals.
- O Aggregate age group winners will be announced

### Relay

 Medals to each member of the winning relay team in each age group of each event.

#### Rules

- This competition will be governed by the rules of Masters Swimming Australia and Masters Swimming NSW in force at the closing date for entries.
- MSNSW SunSmart Sport & No Smoking policies, and MSA Warm-Up Safety policy will apply at this meet- please obey all signs & official instructions.
