# SWIMMING TIPS: THE IMPORTANCE OF FRONT QUADRANT STROKING IN FREESTYLE



#### What is front quadrant stroking?

Essentially, Front Quadrant stroking means there is always one had in front of your head throughout the stroke cycle.

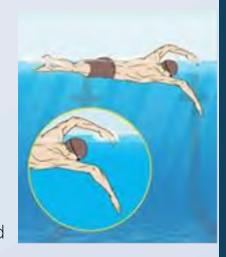

#### Why is it so important?

It makes the Freestyle stroke more efficient. It stops the elbow dropping and crossover in stroke. As swimmers tire, it is easy for the arms to slip through water, missing much of the catch phase.

#### What does it look like?

The opposite hand anchors your breathing in catch entry position. As the breathing arm passes ear and the head is returning to streamlined position, the hand adopts an early vertical forearm position (EVF). EVF is exactly what it sounds like – getting your forearm into a vertical position during the "catch" phase of your stroke as soon as your arm enters the water. The body is in a streamlined position, enabling the power in the catch and pull phase to be maximised, as the hand drives the water backwards, accelerating as the hand passes hips.



#### How to develop front quadrant stroking.

Exaggerate the Front Quadrant stroke in the 'almost catch up" drill. Practice as 25 almost catch up, 25 focus on Front Quadrant stroke.

Recently at the Bowral and Canberra Freestyle clinics, Front Quadrant stroking and EVF were explored. Since attending the workshops some of our swimmers have been absolutely smashing their times at meets and in endurance by focusing on this.
