Our swimmers embraced the warm weather and vibrant atmosphere, returning with impressive times, personal achievements, and lasting memories.



TECHNICAL TIPS

A note from our Technical committee:

At recent swim meets, there were a number of issues causing disqualifications. One of these was the rule requiring a swimmer to touch on turns and at the finish with two hands – simultaneously and separated. The two strokes are Breaststroke and Butterfly.



BREASTSTROKE AND BUTTERFLY: BOTH HANDS MUST TOUCH SIMULTANEOUSLY AND WITHOUT OVERLAPPING AT EACH WALL



SW 7.6 At each turn and at the finish of the race, the touch shall be made with both hands separated and simultaneously at, above, or below the water level.

Butterfly:

SW 8.4 At each turn and at the finish of the race, the touch shall be made with both hands separated and simultaneously at, above, or below the water surface.
